




Bulk Waste Cleanup Days:

Zone 1: April 14, July 21, October 6

Zone 3: April 16, July 23, October 8

Zone 2: April 15, July 22, October 7 **Zone 4:** April 17, July 24, October 9



Holiday that could cause a one-day delay in pickup

Recycling Collection - Zone 1 (1st Wednesday of each month)

Recycling Collection - Zone 2 (2nd Wednesday of each month)

Recycling Collection - Zone 3 (3rd Wednesday of each month)

Recycling Collection - Zone 4 (4th Wednesday of each month

All containers other than Republic Services carts will not be picked up. All recycling must be placed loose inside the cart; no material outside the cart will be picked up.

- All bulk trash needs to be curbside on the ground.
- · All bulk material must be bagged; no loose material.
- · No trailers will be unloaded; they must be on the ground.
- We will accept minimal amounts of construction debris, fencing or building material.

Non-recyclable

These items can never be placed in your recycling cart.

Containers/packing materials

Gift bags (laminated, coated or dyed)

Household cleaners

Liquids of any kind

Medical waste

Packing peanuts (polystyrene foam)

Paint or oil cans

Paper, milk or juice cartons

Pizza boxes

Plastic bags

Polystyrene foam

Propane tanks

Ribbons and bows

Trash of any kind
